10 QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD ASK YOUR KENNEL OR CARE PROVIDER

Research is important when choosing holiday care for your pet.

Whether you are looking for a new boarding facility
or you would just like to check your current kennels,
get answers to these important questions

before booking your dog's next stay.







Can I look around your facilities and grounds?

Looking around a few kennels will give you a good idea of what is available in the area.



What additional services are available?

For example, a dog grooming service, training classes, or safe playtime with other pets.



What are your basic facilities and services?

Take a look at the living and exercise spaces. Are they suitable for your pet?



Can I speak to a few of your current clients?

You can also ask friends and family for a recommendation or look at online reviews.



Are your kennels licensed and insured?

All kennels must have the appropriate level of insurance to protect the animals in their care.



Show me the security you have in place.

Ask about basic security and any additional steps that have been taken to ensure your pet is safe.



Can I see qualifications & experience for your staff?

Ask to have a chat with the staff members who will be responsible for your pet's care.



What happens if my dog becomes ill?

Ask what the procedure is in the case of a veterinary emergency.



How much time will my pet get with the staff each day?

You do not want your pet sat alone in a cage all day, so ask how often your dog will be interacted with.



How do you deal with separation anxiety?

Ask how they can help your dog feel more comfortable about coming to stay with them.
