

# CAT HOLIDAY CARE CHECKLIST



Use our handy checklist to make sure you and your feline friend are ready for your upcoming time away from home



## BEFORE YOU LEAVE:

### GENERAL HEALTH

- Bring your cat in for a summer health check with one of our Vet Nurses to go over the general health of your pet

### VACCINATIONS

- Check your cat's vaccinations are up-to-date, especially if using a cattery or pet sitter with multiple pets
- If your cat's vaccinations are due when you are away, book them in with us before you go for peace of mind

### IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

- Leave the contact details of your Vet in an obvious place
- Leave details of where you are going on holiday and how to contact you

### PREPARE YOUR HOUSE FOR STAY-AT-HOME CARE

- Clean the house, your cat's bedding and litter trays
- Block off dangerous areas and highlight these to your sitter
- Leave your pet care information in an easy to find spot
- Leave a cat carrier ready to go in case of emergency
- Stock up on food and treats for your pet, as well as cat litter
- Leave any medication or parasite products your cat will need

### WHILE YOU ARE AWAY:

- It is worth checking in after the first couple of days and then halfway through your holiday - alternatively, ask your sitter to send you a photo and a quick update each day
- And...relax! If you have prepared well, chances are your cat is enjoying their holiday as much as you are

### NOTES FOR YOUR CAT SITTER:

- Basic information on your pet – name, age etc.
- Food information – type of food and quantities
- Water bowls – where they are and how often to change the water
- Mealtimes – list when and where your cat should be fed
- Short medical history – just the things your pet sitter should know about including allergies and any medication instructions
- Leave details of any recent changes to your cat that you want your sitter to watch out for
